

Washing Machine Safety

It is important to check your washing machine hoses since they are one of the top five sources of preventable water damage in a home. By inspecting these hoses, homeowners can avoid thousands of dollars in damages.

When inspecting your washing machine:

- Check often for signs of leaks, bulging, or cracking in the hoses
- Allow at least four inches of space between the machine and wall to prevent the hose from excessive bending
- Choose a high-quality hose
- Shut off water supply when not in use
- Never leave the washer on while you are sleeping or out of the house.
